 - An 800-1500 word writing sample (article, essay, or research paper) on a key topic that features a high degree of research, critical thinking, and writing ability
 - A 150-250 word proposal on the legal area of interest of your choice that you would like to write a published article on
 - Cover letters are no longer necessary and will not be considered in applications.
