 - A 1-2 page Resume/ CV. (Research Resumes that include publications and research experience are permitted to be longer)
 - 1 page Cover Letter detailing why you want to be a Senior Editor for the Canadian Law Review and whether you have previous editorial or relevant experience.
 - A writing sample written during your time in law school, featuring McGill Citations.

- The Junior Research Fellow applications are officially opening tomorrow. We apologize to anyone who has already submitted the application through the website. **We kindly ask that you resubmit starting tomorrow. We will only be accepting applications through the website.** Please also keep in mind the new requirements:
 - A 1-2 page Resume/ CV. (Research Resumes that include publications and research experience are permitted to be longer)
 - An 800-1500 word writing sample (article, essay, or research paper) on a key topic that features a high degree of research, critical thinking, and writing ability
 - A 150-250 word proposal on the legal area of interest of your choice that you would like to write a published article on
 - Cover letters are no longer necessary and will not be considered in applications.
